<b>Stability and Reactivity</b>	When stored and handled as detailed below, the product is stable. No hazardous reactions or hazardous decomposition products.	
<b>Handling &amp; storage</b>	Keep containers dry and closed. Keep away from foodstuffs. Wash hands thoroughly before breaks and at the end of the working day. Store in a cool and well ventilated place (between -5° C and +25° C) in the original containers
